OUTDOOR SETTINGS

The **Windmill Garden** is our most popular outdoor space for wedding ceremonies and garden parties. Its centerpiece, the Old East Windmill, was built in 1800 in the town of Orleans, MA. It was moved to its present location in 1968 and today stands at attention, overlooking a garden of roses, hydrangeas, day lilies and hostas.

The **Sundial Garden** is ringed in daylilies, which burst with vibrant yellows, pinks, creams and reds in July and August. The area offers a span of welcoming lawn that easily accommodates events of all types.

The **Parade Field** is a stately expanse of lawn adjacent to our History Museum with views of Shawme Pond through the rhododendrons that define the area. This area is popular for larger tented events, or gatherings that have multiple activities.

Our **Estate Lawn** is located in front of the cedar-shingled Colonial that currently houses Heritage's Administrative Offices. This intimate lawn area features a permanent stage that is the perfect area for a band or deejay to set up and perform.

The gently rolling **Round Barn Lawn** is located directly in front of the J.K. Lilly Automobile Museum. It's the perfect setting for smaller parties with close proximity to our main gate. Oftentimes, renters will display one or more of our automobile collection on the lawn as part of their festivity.

For quiet contemplation or an idyllic setting for an artist workshop, the **Shawme Pond Overlook** is a sloping, woody area that touches down at pond's edge. This area accommodates smaller gatherings, is ideal for informal wedding ceremonies of fewer than 50 guests, and offers amazing scenery for picture taking.

The **Upper and Lower Event Fields** offer roomy, grassy locales that are wonderful for hosting reunions, corporate outings, school field trips, and outdoor festivals. Popular for picnics and barbecues, these areas can accommodate field day activities such as softball, kickball, Ultimate Frisbee or volleyball.

INDOOR SETTINGS

Our Shaker round barn houses the **J.K. Lilly III Automobile Museum**. Filled with classic American-made autos, the two-story circular interior with its dramatic vaulted ceiling lends itself well to a festive, flowing gathering. Your guests will marvel at the metal and chrome gems inside, including Gary Cooper's Duesenberg, a Mercer Raceabout, a sleek Auburn Boattail Speedster, and the United States' first presidential limousine.

Whirl about on the wood-carved, 1911 Loeff carousel in our **Art Museum**. With two gallery wings and a central glass rotunda for mingling, the museum is perfect for social gatherings involving children, teas, networking events and smaller wedding receptions. The **Police Gazette Garden** off the backside of the museum is a charming green space for cocktail receptions and is included as part of the rental.

Lecture, workshop and conference meeting space can be accommodated in the Shaker round barn **Auditorium**.
