




All Shows are held on Saturday with a rain date reserved for Sunday. Each event begins at 10am and concludes at 2pm with an award ceremony and car parade except for Corvette Day which concludes at 3pm. Participants compete for various class awards and spectators can vote for their favorite car at each Show. Award winners from 2007 are not eligible for awards in 2008. Goodie bags and dash plaques will be given to the first 100 cars. Show cars will be displayed on various lawns throughout Heritage grounds.

For the first two Shows: registration fee is \$15 in advance and \$20 the day of the Show. Gates open at 8am, registration is 8-10am. Judging will be conducted from 11am-1pm. These shows conclude with the award ceremony at 1:30pm followed by a car parade.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ☆ Registration fee is \$15 per car entered in each Show in advance and \$20 the day of the event. *Corvette registration is done through the Cape Cod Corvette Club.*
- ☆ Deadline for pre-registration is two weeks prior to each show date.
- ☆ Each entry includes two admissions to Heritage Museums & Gardens (a \$24 value), an engraved brass dash plate, and the opportunity to compete for various awards hand-crafted by Pairpoint Glassworks in Sagamore, Massachusetts.
- ☆ Judging classes are determined according to the final roster of cars registered.
- ☆ Cars will be admitted beginning at 8:00am on the Show day.
- ☆ Movement of vehicles during Show hours (10am - 2pm) is restricted. If you must arrive late or leave early, a Museum escort will be required.
- ☆ Please include photographs or digital images for publicity purposes, if available. Heritage Museums & Gardens has the unrestricted right to use entrant's names and/or photographs of vehicles in the promotion of the event.
- ☆ Commercial signs and advertisements are not permitted without permission from Show management.
- ☆ Fire extinguishers are required in all Show vehicles.

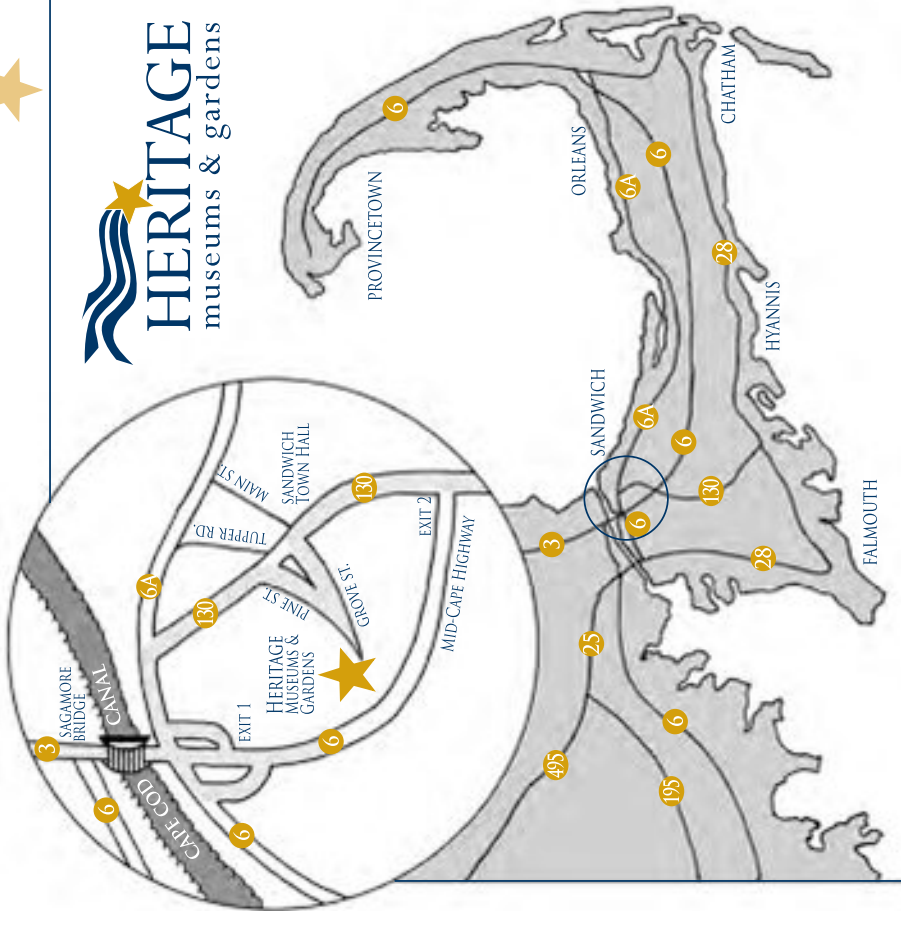

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Follow major routes to Cape Cod. Cross Cape Cod Canal via the Sagamore Bridge onto Route 6. Take exit #2 to Route 130 north into Sandwich Village. Turn left on Grove Street (by Shawme mill pond and Town Hall). Look for orange vested personnel on the left at the HM&G entrance.



"You Can't Get To Town in a Bathtub..." a new vignette celebrating the 100th Anniversary of the Ford Model T will be on view in the J.K. Lilly III Automobile Museum through October 31. Over 15 million were produced and these inexpensive, versatile autos literally put America on wheels. Model Ts took the city folk to the suburbs, the farmers to the market, and pervaded culture in songs, movies and even American language. Have you ever heard of a Tin Lizzie or a Jalopy?

Mixing archival photos, family snapshots, and newsreel movies with the cars themselves, the exhibit will show how people adapted the "the Universal Car" even more. The importance of the Model T is best stated by a farmer's wife interviewed in the 1920s. When asked why she had a brand new Model T but no indoor plumbing she responded, "Why, you can't go to town in a bathtub!"
